## Project Work —

Project work is essential for every company as any change in products, processes, the organisation, assets or resources is a project in essence.

Projects are often complex and come with a high risk of failure or excess of expenses.

To remedy this risk, companies can optimize the pre-requisites and put in place good infrastructure. They can also carry out a number of measures and activities. All of these make up a best practices framework.

Companies demonstrate different maturity levels of structural support for project work.

0 - 20% LOW MATURITY 21 - 40% BASIC MATURITY

41 - 60% MEDIUM MATURITY

61 - 80% ADVANCED MATURITY

81 - 100% BEST PRACTICE MATURITY

## **Project Work Best Practices Framework**

- 1. Guiding Documents: definitions, descriptions, templates, guidelines
- 2. Skills & HR: incentives, trainings, coaching, communities, owners.
- 3. Selection: rationale, cost-benefit.
- 4. Embedding: announcements, staffing, steering, organisational setup.
- 5. Setup: project infrastructure, software, roles & responsibilities, reporting.
- Core Project Work: day-to-day, project methodology, progress tracking, pull.
- 7. Completion: handover, documentation, training, maintenance.
- 8. Tools: Software, project work, notes, databases, communication,

9. Control: reporting, tracking, calculations.
